To Whom it May Concern:

In line with commitments in our Noise & Vibration Management Plan and Community Effects Monitoring and Mitigation Plan, we are notifying you of activities at the mine site.

As reported in our [Oct 10<sup>th</sup> media release](#), first gold pour at Blackwater Mine is targeted for late Q4 2024. As such, it is possible that operations of the mine may begin 30 days from now or sometime thereafter.

Construction related blasting activity at the mine site is currently taking place at the mine site. Once the mine site is in operations, blasting activity for operations will be ongoing.

In the open pit blasting designated area of the mine, explosive charges will be used when necessary to break apart the rock. Please see the map below.

In general, blasting will occur daily between 6am and 7pm. For the purposes of safety and security, we have implemented security processes such that only trained and authorized personnel will be permitted to access designated areas.

Please see the Noise and Vibration Management Plan (EA Condition 21) for information on mitigations to minimize noise, vibration and visual effects related to blasting activities.
